Question #7 • Text Response • 7 responses (70%)
Do you have any recommendations for your TA that would help them be a more effective TA in the future?

Results:

- TA was quite late in uploading the problem sets and did not give us steady time to work on them, based on their difficulty. I would recommend to either give students more time to work on the problem sets or decrease their length in the future. The problem sets built upon the material in a way that surpassed what was taught in the lecture, which, although it may have exposed us to more material, was very disconnected from what was occurring in class. While the TA was very quick to respond to emails, the TA was very reluctant in answering direct questions...students (including myself) had to be very abstract in the questions we asked and ask very broad questions.
- I think Paul had his own challenges with instructing online. The entire structure of the class and the limited guidance Paul provided made the concepts in class very difficult to learn and apply. I think Greg and Paul have similar teaching styles where they try to prompt students to answer their own questions. However, this method was very unhelpful when learning online.
- I understand you are also a student and are extremely busy, but I my only recommendation would be to improve on organization. The files were not uploaded on time sometimes, and there were several typos in the documents which sometimes made the instructions confusing.
- His demonstrations during lab sessions could go by a bit quickly because he's so used to Stata so it was sometimes hard to follow - but I get that we have a lot to

cover so he wouldn't be able to go too slow. Set boundaries for your own well-being!

- We were definitely overusing his time so he should set rigid boundaries when he would be checking his emails and answering our questions. Please be more selfish and protect your time, Paul!!
- No recommendations-- Paul has it all down perfectly!!
